Last fall the negotiating committee did a fine job of concluding bargaining for a two year agreement. That agreement is set to expire April 31, 2014 which means negotiations could start early in 2014.

The Bargaining Strategy Committee will sort through various bargaining barriers, discuss processes during previous rounds of bargaining, look at potential goals for upcoming bargaining and recommend bargaining strategy for 2014 to the membership.
